## Workshops

**C: Children Y: Youth A: Adult Friendly**

**1. Labyrinth** – We acknowledge that we are all pilgrims on a spiritual journey, seeking to draw closer to the Living God. The labyrinth is an ancient form of moving prayer that in itself is a metaphor for this journey. Learn more about the origin of the labyrinth and how this prayer practice can deepen you faith. **CYA**

**2. Scavenger Hunt** – Jesus sent his disciples into the world to preach the Good News and baptize in his name. Jesus sends us too! This workshop will send participants on a scavenger hunt where you will get to know our PCUSA missionaries, pray for the global church, and engage in service to our community. **CYA**

**3. God in Nature** - We encounter God in many ways – including through the world all around us. Join us for a guided walk through nature, as together we will explore how we sense God’s presence in the beauty of nature. **CYA**

**4. Pilgrimage** – In Christianity, we acknowledge life as a sacred journey or pilgrimage in which we continually draw closer to God. Whether one goes to camp or Taize or Iona in search of a “thin space” to encounter God, pilgrimage as a spiritual practice can be a helpful hallmark of Christian faith. Hear from those for whom pilgrimage has been an important part of their journey – and discern if a pilgrimage might be helpful to you. **YA**

**5. Journey through the Wilderness** – Life sometimes leads us to a desert space, where we feel like we’re pushing on through dry land trying to reach a place of promise and plenty. But the wilderness places of our life are rich with teachings. As the desert was a place of liberation and refinement for the Israelites, desert moments can also teach us. **YA**

**6. Immigration** – Throughout scripture, God’s people are continually trying to answer the question: “Who is my neighbor?” God answers with an ever broadening view of who plays this role. Today, our political climate has raised this question in various ways. Explore the needs of migrants and refugees and how we can extend the hospitality of Christ. **YA**

**7. Transitions** – Life’s journey takes us through many transitions – physically, emotionally, and spiritually. With each transition – from birth to death; from teen to adult; from employed to retirement – there is a gain and a loss. Discuss how we might navigate the transitions on our journeys with grace and hope. **YA**

**8. Arts & Crafts** – We worship and serve a creative God, who inspires us to create too! Explore your creative side in this as we use our imaginations and our hands to draw closer to God and one another. **CYA**
