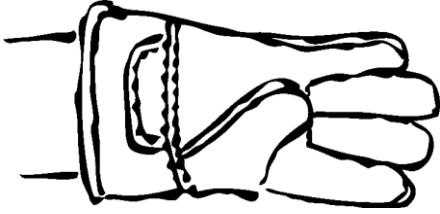

TIMELINE

Wednesday, May 14 ... Mission Trip Permission Form and \$25 deposit due to Sara
Scholarship Forms due, if applicable

Sunday, June 1 after worship ... Mission Trip Meeting with Parents in Parlor

Sunday, July 6 ... Commissioning during 10 am worship

Sunday, August 24 ... Present trip to congregation and families at 10am worship service

REQUIREMENTS FOR GOING ON MISSION TRIP

*Participation in the ongoing life of ELPC such as CLUB 116, church school or worship.

*Attend all mission timeline events listed above including parent's meetings, commissioning and post-trip mission presentation on August 24.

*Submit completed Permission Form and \$25 deposit by May 14. Deposit required, but scholarships available to assist with the remaining cost of the trip.

FINANCIAL DETAILS

*The cost of the trip is \$200.00 per person. Your \$25 deposit is included in this total therefore the difference equals \$175.00.

*SCHOLARSHIPS are available! Money should not be a determining factor for you to not join us on the mission trip. If you are in need of financial assistance please fill out a scholarship form and submit it to Sara Hackett by May 15.
