# **Dance**

#### **Creative Movement**

In partnership with the Pittsburgh Ballet Theatre

This introductory course helps our youngest students discover the joy of music and movement while developing body awareness, rhythm, flexibility, coordination and confidence. By channeling their natural energy and expressiveness, students are encouraged to use their bodies and imaginations in fun ways.

#### **Pre-Ballet A**

In partnership with the Pittsburgh Ballet Theatre

This course introduces the basic techniques, vocabulary and positions of ballet in order to help young dance students build physical strength, improve posture, and increase flexibility. Through the study of ballet students acquire poise, balance, grace, strong muscles and coordination. In the process they develop self-discipline, attention span, and response to rhythm and musical patterns.

#### Bridge Ballet 1

In partnership with the Pittsburgh Ballet Theatre

Selected students are given the opportunity for more focused technique work with other young dancers who share their level of discipline and enthusiasm. Punctuality, attendance, behavior and dress (proper dance clothing) will be held to a higher standard and the expectation is that students will attend every class, on time and dressed appropriately. A new group of students will be selected for a Spring mini-session to prepare them for scholarship auditions at Pittsburgh Ballet Theatre. If you are interested in this class and your child was not in the Spring 2014 Bridge Ballet 1 class, register them for the class recommended for their age (Creative Movement, Pre-Ballet A or B) and then attend the placement session on Saturday, Sept 6 at 10 am.

#### **Ballet 2**

Winter Term

In partnership with the Pittsburgh Ballet Theatre

Students in Ballet 2 learn the fundamental concepts of ballet (turn-out, line, posture and carriage of the upper body) through barre and floor exercises. Repetition will be used to increase strength, flexibility and coordination. Students also gain an appreciation for ballet as an art form as they learn to express themselves through movement to classical music.

#### **Tap Dance**

New for 2014-2015, Hope Academy is offering tap dance as part of its Musical Theater Workshop and Hope Academy Teen Theater Company (HAT Co) programs. If you are interested in tap dance, please sign up for Musical Theater (students in grades 2 & 3, and 4-6) or audition for our teen theater company. HAT Co (grades 7-12).

#### **Important Information for Dance Students**

Register for the dance class based on the age of your child on Sept 1. If you feel that your child should be in a different class, or if you are interested in the Bridge Ballet 1 class, please attend the placement session on Saturday, September 6 at 10 am. The student will be assessed by a PBT instructor and may be re-assigned to a different level, if appropriate.

Because of limited changing facilities, students should come to classes wearing their dance clothes under their street clothes. Parents are asked to remain in the waiting room while their children take class; they will be invited to observe one "open class" at the end of each term. (Dec 13, 2014 and March 21, 2015).

#### **Dress Code for PBT Dance Classes:**

Girls should wear black or pink leotards and tights (or white socks) and leather ballet shoes. Boys may wear a white t-shirt with black shorts or sweatpants, white socks, and leather ballet or jazz shoes. For the safety of the students, those who do not wear leather-soled shoes will not be permitted to take class.

# **HAT Co**

#### (<u>H</u>ope <u>A</u>cademy Teen <u>T</u>heater <u>Co</u>mpany) Acting, Singing, Dance, Rock Band for Teens

This audition-only company provides a more intensive, ensemble- and performance-based experience for students in grades 7 through 12 who are interested in the performing arts. HAT Co members are encouraged to make their own work, as they learn to think about and respect dance, theater and music as art forms -- and themselves.

Selected students receive individual, class and ensemble training in acting, dance, vocal and instrumental music. Classes and ensembles meet all day on Saturday (tap, vocal ensemble, rock band, theater ensemble, extra coaching sessions) and Thursdays after school (ukulele and core dance); private voice and instrument lessons take place after school, during the week.

Students are required to make a yearlong commitment and sign a contract indicating their ability and willingness to attend all scheduled classes, private lessons, rehearsals and performances. Parents/guardians are required to attend an orientation session on Saturday, September 6 at 12 noon.

#### <u>East Liberty Community</u> <u>Engagement Orchestra (EL CEO)</u>

The orchestra is on hiatus this year. In its place will be small ensemble coaching for students who are ready to make music with others. Teaching artists will identify students, pick repertoire and arrange times for ensembles to meet. Ensembles can be as small two, for a duet, and can include vocalists and other teaching artists. Ensembles will prepare for Hope Academy recitals and public performances.

# **Theater**

#### **Musical Theater Workshop 1** — SING, ACT, TAP DANCE!

A fun-filled and exciting musical theater opportunity for 2nd and 3rd graders. This beginning workshop uses games, improvisation activities, creative dramatics and team-building exercises to introduce young children to singing, dancing and acting in a nurturing and non-competitive environment.

This fall term will focus on musical theater and the winter term will focus on monologue and scene work for the Pittsburgh Public Theater Shakespeare Monologue and Scene Contest in February.

#### **HAT Co Rock Band**

This audition-only ensemble for instrumentalists of all kinds: those who play traditional rock instruments (guitar, bass, keyboard, drum set, percussion) and those who want to amp up their more classical instruments to play other kinds of music. Music will be arranged for the instrumentation in the band. All genres of music will be explored, with a strong emphasis on songwriting and recording. #### **Beginning Ukulele Group Class**

Ukuleles are the perfect size for little hands and a great starter instrument for families who might not be ready to make a commitment to private lessons. Children will learn strumming patterns and basic chords as they play and sing. Ukulele's for beginners can be purchased for around \$50. Families will be contacted as their registrations are received to let them know where to purchase their instrument. This is a year-round course and new students will not be accepted after the fall term. Private ukulele lessons are also available.

Students will become confident in independent part reading and learn musicianship.

A parent/guardian is required to attend lessons and classes with their child. Tuition includes a weekly private lesson and weekly group class.

#### **Private Music Instruction**

Private music instruction is available for piano, organ, strings (violin, viola, cello, double bass), woodwinds (flute, clarinet, oboe, saxophone, bassoon), brass (trumpet, French horn, trombone, tuba), percussion, drum set, classical and electric guitar, electric bass, ukulele and voice. New Suzuki piano lessons are available and offered on Saturdays (please indicate on your registration form if you are interested in Suzuki piano).

Lessons are scheduled Tuesdays - Fridays between 2:00 and 8:30 pm and all day on Saturdays. You will be contacted about scheduling when your registration form and payment is received.

Students may register any time during the ten-week session. Payment will be adjusted for the number of weeks remaining in the term. Students are given one makeup lesson per ten-week session. A limited number of *Discover the Talent Scholarships* for private music instruction are available, with preference given to current students.

# **About Hope Academy**

East Liberty Presbyterian Church founded Hope Academy of Music and the Arts in 1999 to bring arts to children and youth in our community. We offer a safe place where young people of diverse ethnic, economic, and religious backgrounds can further their personal and artistic growth through the study and performance of music and the arts.

Hope Academy of Music and the Arts impacts the lives of over 350 children and their families a year through music and performing arts instruction and positive peer and adult interaction, giving students the opportunity to discover hidden skills and talents, and build self-esteem in a supportive, caring environment. The community problem that we address is the lack of opportunity for underserved youth to participate in the arts due to limited resources in the family and cutbacks in arts programming in the schools. The strength and uniqueness of our programming is derived from the partnerships we have developed with some of the city's finest artists and cultural organizations.

### Courses and Private Lessons

Courses are offered in music and the performing arts for children and youth from ages 3 to 18. Course sizes are small to ensure a low student-to-staff ratio.

Private music instruction is also available.

#### **Days and Times**

Most courses and private lessons meet weekly during three terms during the school year - Tuesday through Friday between 2:00 and 8:30 pm; Saturday between 9:00 am and 5:00 pm; and some Sunday afternoons and evenings.

#### Location

Courses and private lessons are held at East Liberty Presbyterian Church, corner of Penn and Highland. Directions and parking information are available on our website.

#### **Attendance**

It is the student's responsibility to attend all scheduled classes. There are no make-up classes or refunds for missed classes.

If an instructor is ill or otherwise unable to teach a class, every effort will be made to find a substitute. Occasionally, it may be necessary to cancel or reschedule a class. Cancellations due to weather will be announced on the local television and radio stations, as well as on the Hope Academy website and facebook page.

Students taking private lessons will be given a maximum of one makeup lesson per term.

HAT Co and Discover the Talent Scholarship students are held to a higher standard. Unexcused absences will result in termination of the scholarship and/or dismissal from HAT Co.

# Registration

Payments by cash must be submitted in person. Onsite registrations will be held on Sept 2 and 5 from 6 to 8 pm AND Sept 6 from 10 am to Noon at East Liberty Presbyterian Church.

Course enrollments are limited. Students will be accepted into a course in the order that their

paid registrations are received. If minimum enrollment for a course is not met by the registration deadline, that course will be cancelled (see Refund Policy). Courses fill quickly. A spot will not be reserved for any student without payment. Call-in registrations will not be accepted.

In order to be intentional about creating a diverse, multicultural community, scholarships, tuition assistance, and half of the available spots for classes will be reserved for students who qualify as being low-income and/or who represent a racial, ethnic or cultural minority. Preference is also given to returning students and families.

IMPORTANT: A separate registration form and \$10 registration fee <u>per term</u> must be submitted <u>for each student</u> registering. This includes registration for FREE courses.

#### Financial Information

#### **Tax-deductible Donations**

Tuition covers only a portion of the total cost of operating Hope Academy of Music and the Arts. Families, who are able, are asked to make tax-deductible donations to cover the difference for their children.

#### **Payment**

The full-tuition amount plus the \$10 registration fee is due at the time of registration.

#### **Scholarships**

Applications for the *Discover the Talent Scholarship* fund are available online at www.HopeAcademyArts.com. **The deadline for receipt of applications is Friday, August 15.** A limited number of scholarships are awarded in September for the entire school year. Application to the *Discover the Talent Scholarship* fund does not guarantee acceptance. You will be notified if you are awarded this scholarship.

#### **Refund Policy**

A full-tuition refund is given for withdrawals from a course 10 days before the course begins. A partial-tuition refund (one-half of the full tuition) will be returned if a withdrawal request is received prior to the second class meeting. No tuition refunds are given after the second class has met, and families are responsible to make full payment of tuition. If Hope Academy cancels a course, you will receive a full-tuition refund for that course. The \$10 registration fee per student is non-refundable except in the event that Hope Academy cancels a course and it is the only course for which the student is registered. No partial refunds are given for missed private lessons. Only 1 makeup lesson will be given per term
