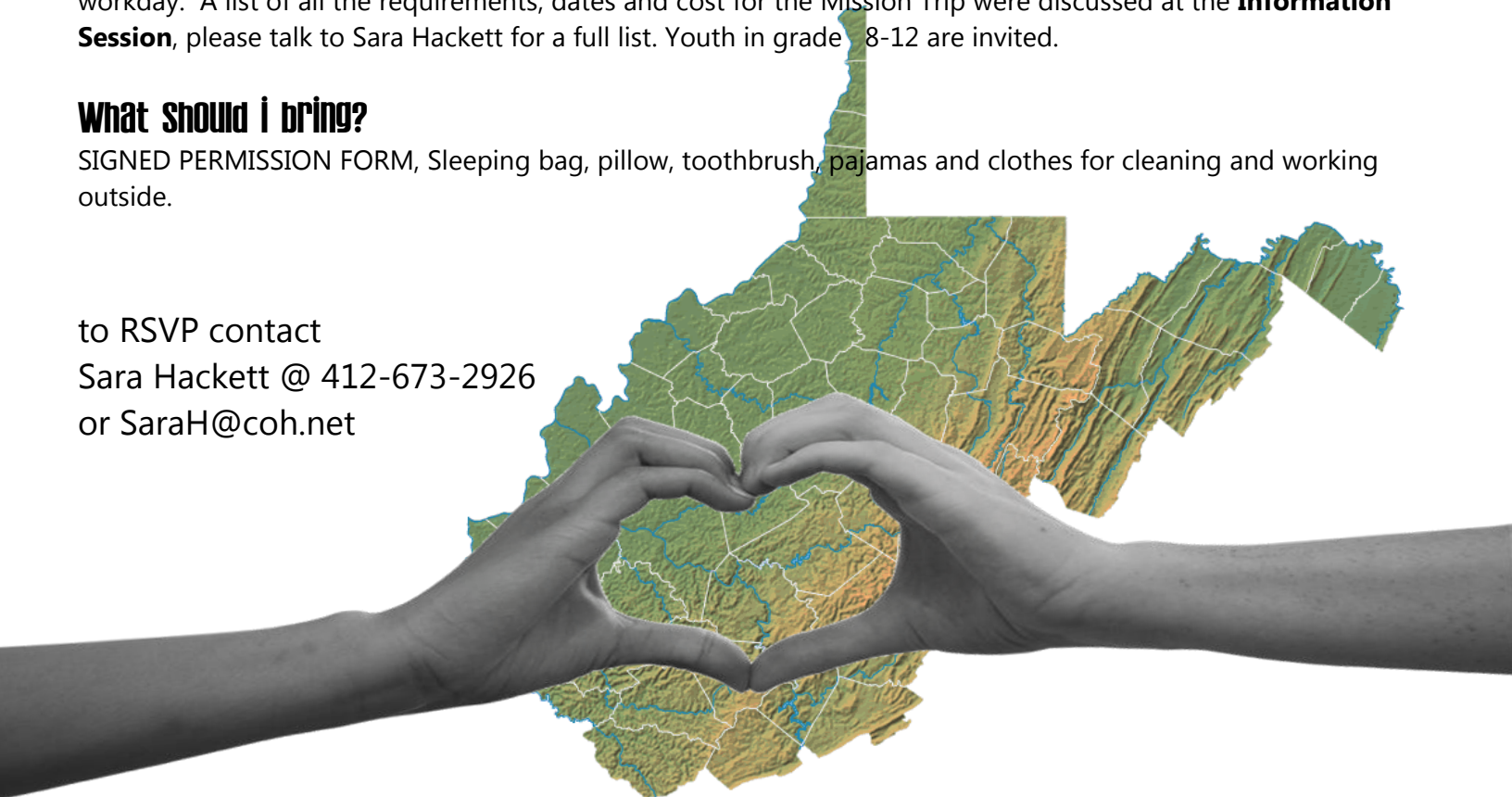
## What should I bring?
