You can put "Highland Park pool" in your GPS. There is plenty of parking along Lake Drive. The pavilion is set back off the road a little bit, across the street from Carnegie Lake (the duck pond).

- 1) Download the app.
- 2) Sign in as a GUEST.
- 3) To get the Join Code contact SaraH@coh.net
- 4) Use the red add response button  to record your 45 second (or less) video to the prompt "Share the most surprising thing you found on the scavenger hunt." You can answer as many times as you want.

Leave things where you find them.

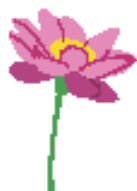
Just mark off that you saw it, show a family member, or take a picture.
