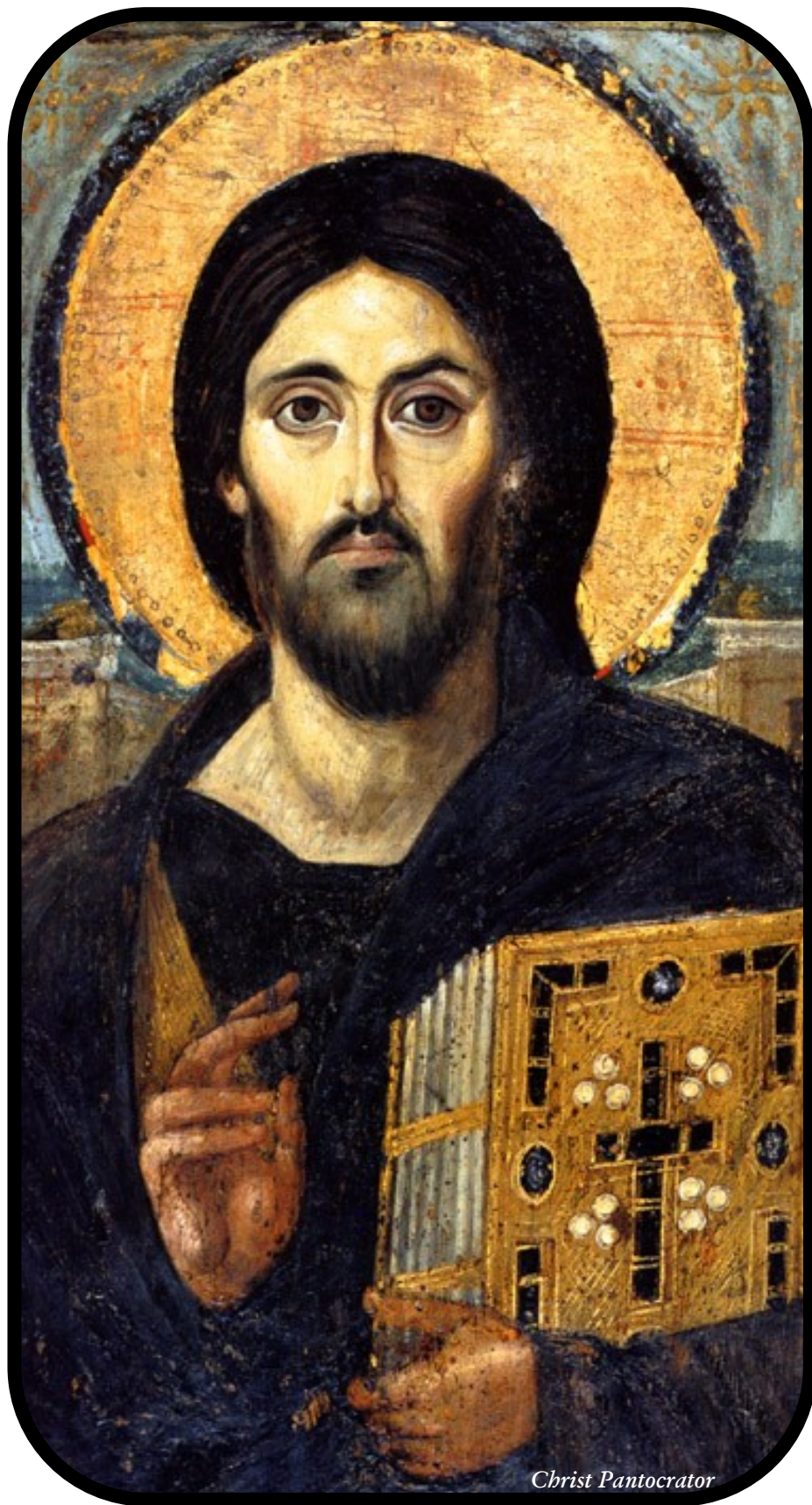

The Word/Meditation: Mark 4:35-41



Other boats were with him. A great windstorm arose, and the waves beat into the boat, so that the boat was already being swamped. But he was in the stern, asleep on the cushion; and they woke him up and said to him, "Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing?" He woke up and rebuked the wind, and said to the sea, "Peace! Be still!" Then the wind ceased, and there was a dead calm. He said to them, "Why are you afraid? Have you still no faith?" And they were filled with great awe and said to one another, "Who then is this, that even the wind and the sea obey him?"

Words from Brother Alois of the Taizé Community

Jesus said to his disciples, "I give you my peace." It is not up to us to create this peace: all we can do is receive it. This peace of Christ is not primarily a feeling in us that calms us. More deeply, it manifests itself in our relationship with others. Christ is our peace: he impels us to open ourselves to others and even to bear tensions without fear. It is this approach that allows peace of heart. Yes, through the inner peace we receive from Christ, we can become bearers of peace and reconciliation in the human family.






